Since 2008, coins have made up the Royal Coat of Arms.


The 3 lions in the top left is England.



- The first successful credit union was opened by Hermann Schulze-Delitzsch in 1849 in southern Germany.
- The first credit union in the UK opened it's doors in 1964 and today, there are 305 seperate credit unions who serve over 1.2 million people up and down the country.
- 223 million people in our beautiful world are part of a credit union.
- Credit union's don't work for profit. They are run by the people who save and borrow with them: The members.
- The people in charge at a credit union are called the Board of Directors. They are lovely people who volunteer (work for free) to keep the credit union working.
- Discovery Credit Union helps the people in your area and your area alone. The credit union offers help to people in the post codes that begin with DD1 to DD7.
- In Ireland, 77% of the people are members of a credit union. The Irish are passionate about working together to help each other in the community which is what credit union's are all about.
- Credit unions in the UK hold £1.25 BILLION worth of savings safe and secure. All the money is protected in the same way banks protect their money.
